THE ERAS THE MUSIC DIED

- **Bible Times** (1800 BC – 90 AD) – singing with Israel and Church
- **Patristic Age** (200-400 AD) – instruments were discouraged
- **Middle Ages** (500-1500 AD) – singing was eliminated
- **Reformation** (1500-1700 AD) – singing returned


SING PRAISE FOR HIS GLORIOUS SALVATION (1-2)

- 15:1 Then Moses and the people of Israel **sang** this **song** to the Lord, saying, “I will **sing** to the Lord, for he has **triumphed gloriously**; the horse and his rider he has thrown into the sea.

SING PRAISE FOR HIS GLORIOUS SALVATION (1-2)

- ² The Lord is my strength and my song, and he has become my salvation; this is my God, and I will praise him, my father's God, and I will exalt him.

SING PRAISE FOR HIS CONQUERING VICTORY (3-10)

- ³ **The Lord is a man of war; the Lord is his name.** ⁴ “Pharaoh’s chariots and his host he cast into the sea, and his chosen officers were sunk in the Red Sea.

SING PRAISE FOR HIS INCOMPARABLE DOMINANCE (11-17)

- ¹¹ **“Who is like you, O Lord, among the gods? Who is like you, majestic in holiness, awesome in glorious deeds, doing wonders?”**



SING PRAISE FOR HIS INCOMPARABLE DOMINANCE (11-17)


- 13 “You have led in your **steadfast love** the people whom you have **redeemed**; you have **guided** them by your **strength** to your holy abode.



SING PRAISE FOR HIS ETERNAL RULE (18-21)


- **18 The Lord will reign forever and ever.”**

ZEPHANIAH 3:17


- The Lord your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing.”
